



Fourth Grade Supply List 2018-19

Organization will be key to a fourth grader's success in school!

1 three-ring binder - 1" or 1 ½" width. Clear plastic pockets on cover for decorating, if your student prefers. Please find one with pockets. This notebook will hold the weekly spelling list, vocabulary list, Bible verse, Bible Journal, notes for history and science, paragraph writing, and more, but will be emptied on a weekly basis.

8 dividers for the binder. Please invest in reinforced dividers.

Pencil case (with three holes) to keep inside the binder for pencils and note cards

Lined paper - wide-ruled, reinforced holes work best. Students will keep binder sections supplied with paper.

Graph paper - packaged (not as a notebook), for math class

Large pencil box or plastic case - sturdy, to keep in cubbies with extra supplies as follows:

- **Ruler:** one 6" and one 12" transparent, if possible
- **Pencils:** a good supply to start the year (recommended: 24)
- **Colored pencils:** for map work; a small pack is fine
- **Pens:** fine tip, blue or black ink only, no neon colors
- **Scissors**
- **Glue sticks:** large and small are both nice to have (a tip: don't buy too far ahead or they dry out!)

3x5 index cards - package for vocabulary and for science

ESV Bible - that can be marked up and kept at school

Old backpack - for back of chair to hold supplies

Water bottle or permanent cup - for classroom water drinking
