



What are the benefits of participating in a Special Purpose Entity?

- Receive a 90% PA state-tax credit toward your individual PA tax liability
- Provide scholarships to students at the private school of your choice

What do I need to do to participate?

- Individuals must work for a for-profit business or own a business
- If you work for a non-profit or a government entity you meet one of the following qualifications:
 - o File taxes jointly and your spouse works for a for-profit business or owns their own business
 - o Own or purchase one share of a stock in a company that pays taxes in PA (example: Your local bank or utility company)
- Commits to participate and contribute for 2 years

- 2. What is your tax liability? Look at last years liability or talk to your accountant.
- 3. Do you have the cash liquidity to make your contribution soon after signing a joinder agreement?
